Weber goes to daycare because we feel bad leaving him at home alone everyday. It's a nice treat for him once a week to get out of the house, socialize, and spend some energy!

I used daycare initially so my 3 month old puppy would not be home alone for 10-12

hours at a time, now I take him whenever we can because it turned out to be the best way to socialize, exercise and discipline my **Sarge**—and I love to watch his little butt wiggle when he approaches the pack leaders in the morning!

After trying 3 other day care places to socialize my rescue GSD, Canine to Five is the ONLY place where my beautiful **Ava** RUNS to the Pack Leaders—never once glancing back at me! She loves it there and I don't need to watch the live stream video to know that she is being cared for in a safe, disciplined, loving, and friendly environment! She didn't know how to play with other dogs until I brought her to Canine to Five.

To socialize and get my dog familiar with various dogs, settings, people and situations. She loves people but is shy/anxious around other dogs when not regularly socialized.

We use dog day care to help my dog be more active and socialize! Since he tends to be a lazy pug, we like to try to bring him around others so he can run around. Also super helpful for when we travel!

Socialization, to avoid long hours at home alone all week and knowing that **Kiley** is being engaged by extremely knowledgeable dog people.

Roxy goes to daycare 1. When I'm running late in the morning/have a long work meeting that day.

2. It's beautiful out and I feel guilty keeping her cooped up all day.

3. It's freezing out and even the thought of taking her for a walk makes me want to hibernate till spring.

4. She loves going!

Because as a working mother with a full time job sometimes you need a little help. You won't just leave your child with anyone, there are day care standards that must be met (which Canine To Five exceeds) I love that I can see him play throughout the day via web cams and Flickr which helps my separation anxiety. They take good care of my **Theo** baby. Plus, he is so tired at the end of the day I can sweep and mop without him attacking the broom! ... Or the fact that I love to spoil my fur baby... No shame in my game!

The exercise/play aspect is great about daycare but the best part is that it keeps **Millie** socialized with all kinds of dogs and humans too! Creates a well rounded pup if you ask me.



Canine to Five gives me the opportunity to help wear out a very high energy dog when the weather does not allow for outdoor activity. **Phaedra** is always tuckered out on her play days and I can see in the Flickr photos that she is having lots of fun.

I use daycare for **Ruby** and **Luna** to socialize them with other pups (they're VERY dependent on each other!) and to wear them out when the humans will be out of the house in the evenings. Definitely relieves the guilt when I know they're completely exhausted from a fun day with their friends!

I use Canine to Five daycare for many reasons. **Emmie** is still a puppy and I don't want her to forget how to socialize with dogs, especially now that it is colder. I also use daycare because I feel guilty leaving her in her crate while I am at work for 8+ hours. I feel better knowing she is having fun and in a safe environment. Also, Emmie comes home exhausted and she doesn't have the energy to annoy my two kitties (which makes them happy and they want to cuddle with her).

So I don't come home to a house destroyed by an overly excited and full of energy dog.
